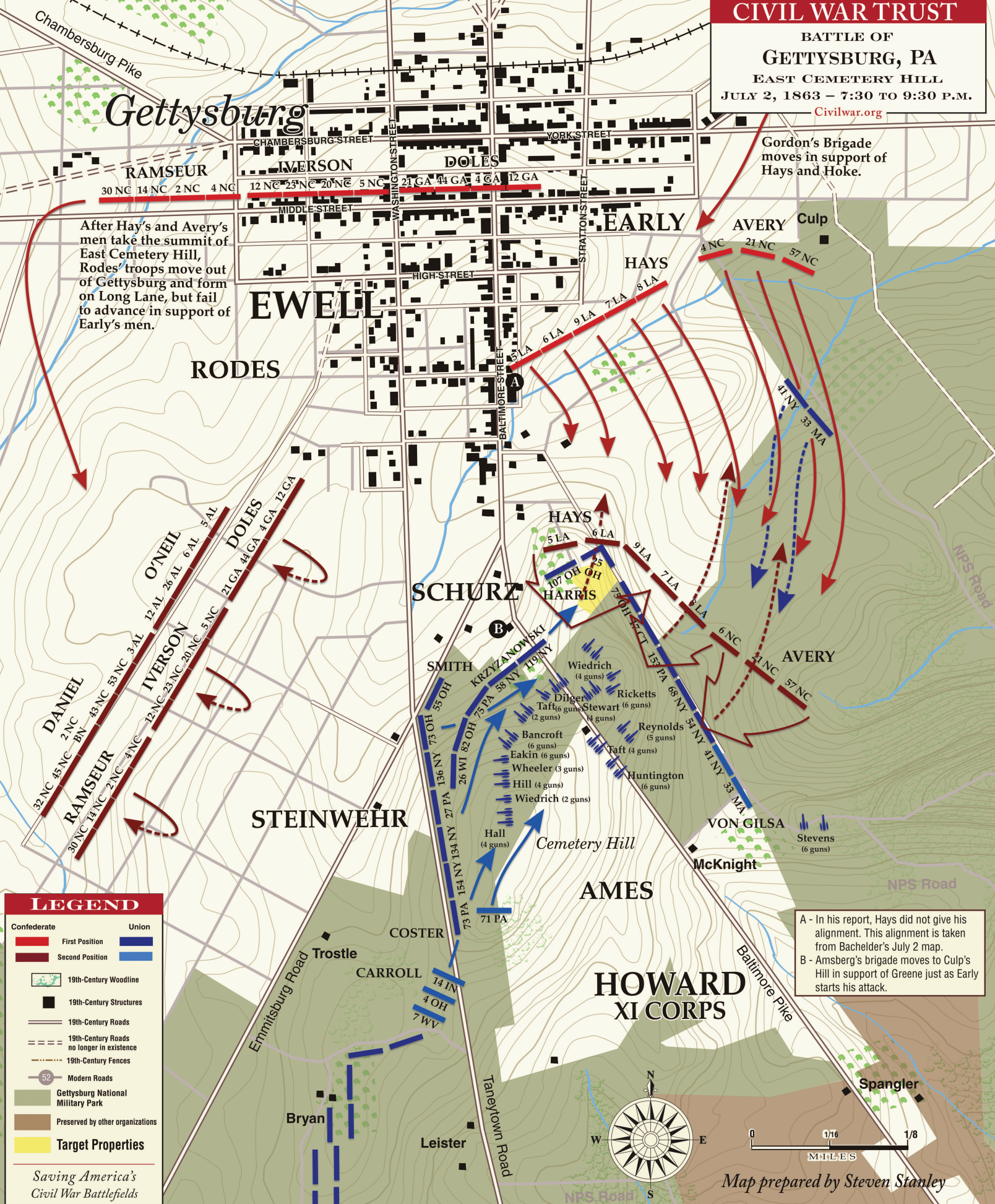

After Hays and Avery's men take the summit of East Cemetery Hill, Rodes' troops move out of Gettysburg and form on Long Lane, but fail to advance in support of Early's men.
