Honolulu Area Transit Map

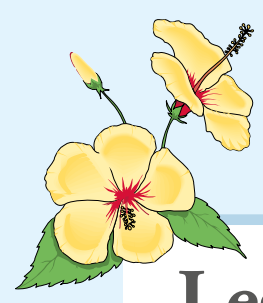

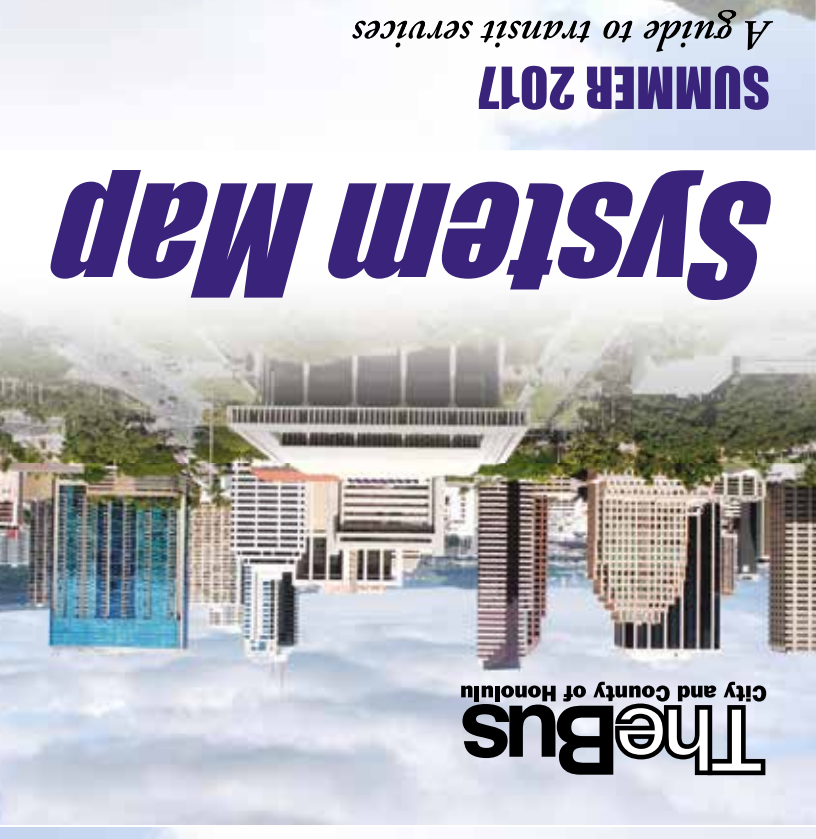
